Tuesday 21st January at 12 noon to 1.30pm, the Durham Churches Together lunch for The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is at Waddington Street United Reformed Church. All welcome – no booking needed.

Date for the Diary - Sunday 9th February at 2.30pm in the parish room at St. Cuthbert's, Old Elvet, Durham.: There will be an illustrated talk by Richard Pears (university librarian) entitled 'Catholic Country House Building in Durham and Northumberland 1570-1829'.

From the excommunication of Queen Elizabeth I to the Catholic Emancipation Act, Catholic families were persecuted, fined and excluded from public office and universities. Despite this, many of the wealthier Catholic families retained their lands and rebuilt their mansions in fashionable architectural styles.

In this talk, Richard Pears will examine these country houses and argue that exclusion from English society increased their engagement with European culture, in particular the architecture of the Italian renaissance. By adopting the architecture of classical Rome the families signified their continuing devotion to the Roman Catholic Church. The talk is free but donations towards the church building repairs will be welcome
