Volunteer Drivers

Please check your insurance to ensure they are covered should an accident occur when undertaking church-related journeys. Many motor insurance policies include such cover, or can be upgraded without cost, but some do not.

The Diocese ask volunteer drivers to sign an annual volunteer driver's form to confirm they have suitable motor insurance for church-related activities.. Those who have signed the form previously are asked to renew their declaration. However, if you are a new volunteer driver please contact the Parish Secretary who will arrange for a form to be provided. Alternatively the form may be downloaded from the parish website, completed and then returned to the parish secretary. Examples of church activities include:

- those who use cars to take communion to the housebound
- driving to the bank with collection monies,
- being part of a rota If in doubt, you are strongly advised, for your own sake, to contact your insurance company as there can be grey areas. Many thanks.


